Aram Public Library Policy 6.3 Wireless Internet Policy

Revised February 14, 2014

Aram Public Library provides free wireless internet access throughout the library building. This access may be used provided the user complies with the following conditions.

- 1. Using the connection for the posting of any unlawful, threatening or abusive information as defined by the law or encouraging conduct that would constitute a criminal offense is prohibited.
- 2. Purposely posting or downloading files or software containing a virus, worm or any other potentially harmful component is prohibited.
- 3. Attempting or assisting to attempt unauthorized access to any computer system is prohibited.
- 4. The wireless network at Aram Public Library is an unsecured network. The library accepts no responsibility for any unauthorized access to a patron's computer through the library network.
- 5. The library accepts no responsibility regarding the ability of patron-owned equipment to connect the wireless network.
- 6. Library staff are not permitted to assist patrons with use of a patron's equipment.
- 7. The user understands that the library may be recording the MAC (machine access code) of their device and will release said code if required by law. If the user is found to be abusing their wireless privilege for illegal purposes, said user will be held liable for all monetary penalties and court costs.
- 8. When entering an access code, the patron acknowledges and accepts the wireless policy.
