Women With Words is a philanthropic initiative to sponsor the new Youth Gallery Wall at the Aram Public Library in Delavan. The new space is part of the renovation and expansion plan to add 23,000+ square feet to the existing facility (established in downtown Delavan in 1908). A capital campaign is currently underway to raise funds for this project, a mix of public and private support.

Women With Words, celebrates strong women as a legacy of love – ourselves, mothers, sisters, grandmothers, daughters, and friends. Honorees will be listed on the new Youth Art Gallery Wall – almost 50 feet in length – a space that connects the adult, young adult, makerspace, and children's areas. Cost is estimated at \$50,000 to be raised through \$500 donations.
